Driving Directions from the Capital Beltway (I-495)

- Get on the Capital Beltway (I-495). Be sure you are heading toward Bethesda and Silver Spring, Md.
- Take the Georgia Ave. (MD 97) South exit (no. 31).
- Coming off the exit ramp, continue on Georgia Ave. through downtown Silver Spring (about 3 miles). Stay in the left lanes. The fifth light after Colesville Rd. will be Sligo Avenue; you will see a sign for MD410 (East-West Hwy. pointing left).
- Turn left onto Sligo Ave. (if you go under a railroad bridge, you've missed the turn).
- Continue on Sligo until the first light -- Fenton Ave.; you will see a Greyhound/ Peter Pan bus station on your left, and a 7-Eleven across the street.
- Turn right onto Fenton and continue until it intersects with Philadelphia Ave. on the left and Burlington Ave. on the right.
- Turn right onto Burlington, going uphill, and look for Selim Road on the right (top of the hill; do not cross Georgia Ave.).
- Turn right onto Selim. Capital Aikikai is no. 945, about halfway down the street, on the right (look for the blue door).
